As an educational organization, generous donations from industry are an important part of our work. SEI implements these hardware donations into several facets of our work including student training through dedicated lab stations, traveling lab kits and classroom displays. Additionally, these donations make projects possible that may otherwise be economically unfeasible. Projects with the public schools, Native American communities and developing world countries are just a few examples. This past year, SEI was able to install a 1.55kW grid tie system with students at the Crested Butte Community School as part of our Solar In the Schools (SIS) program.
