We will continue to do this by:

- Implementing robust systems to ensure we remain compliant in an evolving legislative landscape, identify and control risks, and prevent pollution.
- Identifying and assessing the environmental benefits and costs of our activities and using this information to make decisions consistent with our values and aspirations.
- Engaging with traditional custodians, and other people potentially affected by proposed activities, to help identify the environmental benefits and costs of our activities.
- Collaborating with customers, suppliers, regulators and industry groups to develop innovative approaches to reduce waste, water consumption and air emissions.
- Building capability within our organization so that the environmental aspects of our activities are understood and considered in decision making across our organisation, and we are able to prevent or minimize negative impacts and maximise positive impacts.

On a global scale BP is committed to a strategy that is consistent with the Paris Agreement on Climate Change and has announced specific greenhouse gas emissions reduction targets. Our low carbon ambitions also focus on improving products and creating low carbon businesses. Locally we are developing an emissions reduction program in support of these global commitments.
