2012 up to date Highlights



- COP construction activities 62% complete and progressing on plan
- Shah Deniz FFD selected a single pipeline option to Italy with a single pipeline to Central Europe decision to be made end of June
- Shah Deniz Stage 2 approved the decision to commence FEED
- BTC loaded the 1,870th tanker at Ceyhan
- "Shafag-Asiman" completed the first 3D seismic acquisition
- ACG achieved a total of 2.0 bn barrels of oil production milestone
- Shah Deniz achieved 2.0 bn cubic metres of gas production during 1Q


Shah Deniz full field development – concept and planned activities

Existing Stage 1 Platform




2000 km transit across Turkey New terminal at Sangachal with compressors for Shah Deniz and SCP

Shafag-Asiman

- Water depth: 600-800m
- 60km from Shah Deniz;
 145km from Sangachal terminal
- Deep (7000m) reservoirs
- Expected very high subsurface pressures

Exploration

- 3D seismic acquisition conducted
- Exploration well, timing of which to be determined by availability of infrastructure
