2014 highlights



- West Chirag delivered First Oil
- ACG achieved a total of over 2.5 billion barrels of oil production since first oil
- ACG delivered 8 oil producer wells and 1 water injector well
- BTC loaded the 2 billionth barrel of crude at Ceyhan
- Shah Deniz continued plateau production
- Shah Deniz delivered a total of about 53 billion cubic metres of gas and about
 14 million tonnes of condensate since start
- SD2 and SCPX awarded 15 main contracts and the projects continued to progress to schedule
- 'Shafag-Asiman' completed 3D seismic data processing

Shah Deniz Stage 2 and SCPX




Contracts to sell gas to Turkey (6bcma) and Europe (10 bcma)

Existing Stage 1 platform Two new bridge-linked platforms providing 16 bcma offshore processing




1,900km TANAP pipeline across Turkey

New gas and condensate processing facilities with a compressor at Sangachal 360km of subsea pipelines and 125km of subsea flow-lines in up to 550m water depth 26 subsea wells drilled with two semi-submersible rigs

Shafag-Asiman exploration





Shafag-Asiman:

- Water depth: 600-800m.
- 60km from Shah Deniz;
 145km from Sangachal terminal.
- Deep (7,000m) reservoirs.
- Expected very high subsurface pressures.

Exploration:

- 3D seismic acquisition conducted.
- Exploration well, timing of which to be determined by availability of infrastructure.




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Employment of Azerbaijani nationals
