## 3Q 2020 highlights – ACG operations



- ACG completed ten oil producer wells during the first three quarters of 2020.
- Total oil production from ACG since start has reached more than 3.8 billion barrels.



### 3Q 2020 highlights – ACE project



- Engineering and procurement works continued in support of the project plan.
- Topsides and drilling facilities
   fabrication activities continued at
   the Bibi-Heybat yard with major
   topsides lifts already started.
- Drilling derrick has arrived at the ATA yard, with all three sections of the derrick safely offloaded from the barge and positioned at the site's construction location.
- Jacket fabrication progressed at the Heydar Aliyev Baku Deepwater Jackets Factory with the pin piles already completed, successfully loaded out and driven into the seabed ready to receive the platform jacket.





#### 3Q 2020 highlights – Shah Deniz operations



- Shah Deniz has produced more than 130 billion cubic metres of gas and more than 31 million tonnes of condensate since start.
- The Khankendi vessel continued the installation of the Shah Deniz 2 subsea production infrastructure.
- Pipelay Barge Israfil
   Huseynov successfully
   completed the mechanical
   installation of flowlines to
   East South flank on 8
   October, marking a major
   milestone in the project
   scope.



#### 3Q 2020 highlights – Sangachal terminal



- During the first three quarters of 2020, the Sangachal terminal exported about 183 million barrels of oil and condensate and more than 13 billion standard cubic metres of Shah Deniz gas.
- The daily exporting capacity of the terminal is currently 1.2 million barrels of oil and condensate and
   105 million cubic metres of gas (including 85 million cubic metres for Shah Deniz gas)



#### 2020 exploration highlights

- On the Shafag-Asiman offshore block, the first exploration well was spudded on 13 January 2020. Drilling activities currently ongoing at the depth of 3864 m.
- On D230, a 3D seismic acquisition programme was successfully completed on 14 March 2020 and the processing of the full seismic data completed in October.
- In the third quarter, the ESIA for the first SWAP well was disclosed and public discussions are ongoing.




#### Employment of Azerbaijani nationals
