

Changes relating to conditions of use of BP Fuel Cards February 2022 compared to the conditions of use of BP Fuel Cards September 2021.

This document sets out the changes contained within the conditions of use of bp fuel cards February 2022, to reflect our further obligations as a licensed entity:

- We've updated the definition of B2M, and added definitions of Charity, Conditions of Use, Consumer and Micro-enterprise.
- We've added a new clause 1.2(f) to clarify that references in the Conditions of Use to laws or regulations include updates, as well as successor laws and regulations.
- We've added new wording to clause 2 to make clear that micro-enterprises and charities are subject to the new Annex.
- We've added new wording to clause 3 clarifying that customers agree to use the cards as authorized by B2M, and clarifying how consent for transactions is given and when B2M will process transactions.
- We've updated clause 4 to clarify our charging processes where a currency exchange takes place.
- We've amended the postal address to which our cards should be returned in clause 6.4.
- We've added an Annex, which sets some alternative rights and obligations that apply to customers meeting the definition of Micro-enterprise or Charity.
