In 2015, 30 indigenous Papuans from Teluk Bintuni received entrepreneurship training in AC maintenance and clothing manufacture. Since then, their business have a combined gross revenue of more than Rp 680 million

## 4+4MV

Tangguh supplies 4+4MW of power to PLN, for villages around Tangguh LNG. 9 villages have received electricity, with a further technical evaluation that may enable a further 4MW in the future to light more villages
