In October 2022, bp-AKR introduced **wildbean café** at bp Pangeran Antasari service station, South Jakarta which is the first coffee shop in Indonesia which is owned and managed by bp-AKR.

## Tangguh LNG


bp has been operating Tangguh LNG since 2009. Located in Teluk Bintuni, Papua Barat Province it is a fully integrated LNG operations – from bringing gas from the bay, to processing it in our two-train onshore liquefaction facility, and delivering the LNG to customers.

We are currently working to expand the Tangguh LNG plant by adding a third train, which will increase Tangguh's production capacity to a total of 11.4 million tonnes per annum (mtpa). Tangguh train 3 was deemed a National Strategic Project, as per Presidential Decree No. 58/2017.

More than 99% of our team is Indonesian, with more than half of our people being local Papuans.

### Vorwata carbon capture utilization and storage (CCUS)

#### — Agung I and II exploration blocks

bp has signed a 30-year production sharing contract for Agung I and Agung II exploration blocks in offshore Bali, East Java, West Nusa Tenggara and South Sulawesi with the government of Indonesia.

Since these programmes were first implemented in 2005, Papua Barat - particularly communities in the villages around Tangguh LNG - has benefited from the continual development of Tangguh plant.

### Programme highlights

US\$ 40 Million

have been invested in social investment programmes since 2006, covering health, education, governance, community development and entrepreneurship programmes for Papuans.

Scholarship programme for Papuan students, including a three-year Tangguh technician apprentice programme where selected Papuan students can obtain international certification and be part of Tangguh's future talent pool.

Over

1,300 Papuan students

so far have received scholarships for high schools and universities.

Initiated an alternative energy pilot project to help meet the communities' demand for electricity, by building the first solar panel and wind turbine at a number of public facilities in Arguni and Taroy Districts in Bintuni.

More than

Rp 4 trillion

in contract value with 30 Papuan companies involved in the supply chain for Tangguh project from 2006.

Tangguh LNG, together with Teluk Bintuni Regency and Papua Barat Provincial Governments, facilitated COVID-19 vaccine distribution and vaccination programme in Teluk Bintuni, for surrounding communities and Tangguh workers.

Tangguh LNG, together with Fakfak Regency Government, provided 500 food supply packages for communities, to help with economic recovery to those impacted by COVID-19.

Provided capacity-building trainings for Tangguh workers coming from surrounding villages such as English, computer skills and machinery.

Since 2017, more than

### 3,500 Indigenous Papuans

from Bintuni and Fakfak have worked in Tangguh Train 3 project, as well as participated in training programmes to upskill and access better work opportunities in the future.

### 72.7% of Workers

in Tangguh operations are from Papua (data as per December 2022).

Since 2015, SUBITU – a local business run by indigenous communities with Tangguh's support – has expanded into

### 8 business units


in Teluk Bintuni, Sorong, and Manokwari. Among them are:


