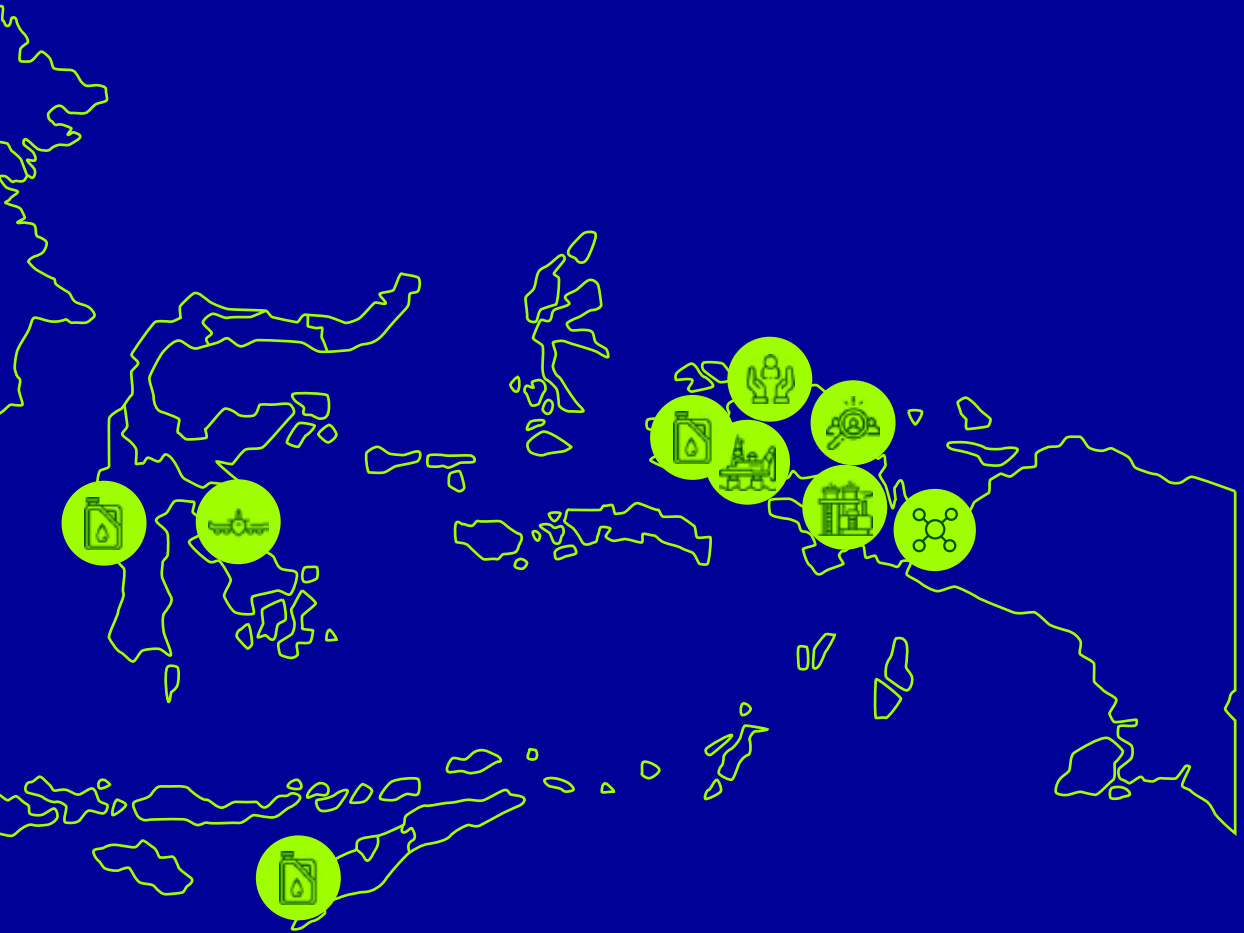

Our approach to sustainability is built on strong foundations that guide the way we work and support our net zero, people and planet aims.

Some of Tangguh's **contributions** to communities and sustainability are:

→ Health

Supporting mother and child health programmes in districts around Tangguh LNG, including **maternity and infant nutrition classes**.

With our programmes' support, from 2021-2024,

maternal death cases went down to 0

and neonatal deaths were reduced **from 10 to 3.**

In 2024,

stunting prevalence in the districts around Tangguh LNG was 13%

— below the national average.
