"We are committed to providing our customers the best offer possible and are continuing to progress our responsible sourcing and sustainability options."

BP also offers customers used Wild Bean Cafe coffee grinds to take home for their gardens, utilises a water recycling programme in its carwashes and is introducing compostable coffee cups by the end of 2018.
