Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments following the Air Resources Board's (CARB) recent workshops to commence development of the 2022 Scoping Plan update. With an ambition to become a net zero company by 2050 or sooner, and to help the world get to net zero, bp is actively engaged in advocating for policies that support this ambition. We look forward to continuing this engagement as CARB develops the 2022 Scoping Plan update for the Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS) and Cap & Trade programs.

In addition to our long-time support for California's market-based approach to reducing greenhouse gas emissions, bp is also actively supporting climate change policies throughout the US, including the Transportation and Climate Initiative, a regional collaboration seeking to reduce transportation carbon emissions across 12 East Coast states and the District of Columbia. We also assumed a leadership role in advocating for Washington state cap and invest legislation, which passed earlier this year.

California's climate programs have created a model for other jurisdictions and a market in which bp is actively engaged, including our participation in the state's LCFS program through the production of low carbon fuels. In addition, LightSource bp, our joint venture solar company, is headquartered in San Francisco and we have an electric vehicle charging pilot program in Northern California.

We support CARB's commitment to staying the course with its successful approach to reducing greenhouse gas emissions as it looks towards achieving carbon neutrality by 2045, while at the same time looking for ways to improve these programs. This provides the certainty necessary for making the kinds of investments that will drive carbon reductions.

As California and CARB continue to lead the way in policy development to fight climate change, bp looks forward to working with you in the development of the 2022 Scoping Plan Update.
